DETAILS FOR NJROTC NATIONALS!

SUMMARY:

- Taking a team of 40 cadets, 7 supporting cadets, 3 parent chaperones and 3 NJROTC teachers.
- Depart on Wednesday, April 15 and return Monday, April 20.
- Miss 4 days of school, April 15-20.

SPENDING MONEY AND MEALS:

- Bring \$100 cash.
 - o Chief King will collect \$20 cash from everyone going to pay for meals on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, plus breakfast on Monday.
 - o Cadets are recommended to have \$80 cash for:
 - Meals on Wednesday as we travel to Pensacola (lunch at airport, fast food dinner)
 - Meals on Sunday in Pensacola (museum in morning, beach in afternoon, movie after dinner)
 - Meals on Monday as we travel back home (fast food lunch, dinner at airport)

PACKING: Arrive at Troy with:

- Uniform in the NJROTC garment bag
- Bring other clothing and personal items in a garbage bag. We will transfer them to large duffel bags (2 cadets/bag) to reduce airline luggage expenses. The garbage bag will be used as a dirty clothes bag during the trip.
- Care should be taken to keep the uniform cover and shoes clean and unscuffed for the trip
- Allowed one carry-on (backpack, laptop, etc.)
- Wear NJROTC jacket
