

Troy NJROTC PROMOTION/ADVANCEMENT STANDARDS

- E-2, Seaman Apprentice
- Recite all 11 General Orders from memory
 - Execute stationary drill (facing movements, attention, hand salute)
- E-3, Seaman
- At least 2 months of time as an E-2
 - Recite NJROTC chain of command from memory
 - Explain Training Time Out
 - Execute drill movements as a member of the platoon
- E-4, Petty Officer Third Class
- At least 3 months as an E-3
 - Pass a written test (80%) on NJROTC uniforms
 - Pass a rifle drill test
- E-5, Petty Officer Second Class
- At least 3 months as an E-4
 - Pass a written test (80%) on leadership, NJROTC rank structure
 - Pass a Platoon Commander drill test
- E-6, Petty Officer First Class
- At least 3 months as an E-5
 - Pass a written test (80%) on Navy and Marine Corps rank structure
 - Pass a guidon drill test
- E-7, Chief Petty Officer
- At least 3 months as an E-6
 - Pass a written test (80%) on NJROTC uniforms
 - Pass a color guard drill test
- E-8, Senior Chief Petty Officer and E-9, Master Chief Petty Officer
- Assigned as either Battalion CMC or Company SCPO
 - Must pass E-6 test within 1 month of assignment
- O-1, Ensign
- At least 3 months as an E-7 or assigned to battalion billet
 - Pass a sword drill test within 1 week of assignment
- O-2 and higher
- Assigned to battalion billets
 - Pass sword drill test within 1 week of assignment
- Notes:
- Completion of Basic Leadership Training will grant an advancement to the next rank.
 - Time in rate is frozen from graduation to the start of school.
 - Battalion staff can recommend meritorious promotions to the NJROTC teachers
